Best Practice 1:

Title of Practice: RLT's COVID -19 Relief Task Force

Objectives of the Practice:

- To prepare and distribute sanitizer.
- Mask preparation and distribution
- Awareness Campaign to fight against Covid-19
- Cleaning and Sanitation Drive
- To provide P.G Students as Corona warriors to Government hospitals
- To help local community for their wellbeing during lockdown period.

The Context:

COVID-2019 pandemic is an unprecedented health challenge during this year. After the outbreak of the novel COVID-19, the World Health Organization (WHO) declared Global Health Emergency as COVID-19 Pandemic. It becomes necessary to follow the advice of WHO and guidance issued by national and local health authorities. Helping society and raising awareness through proper orientation on personal hygiene during this Corona Pandemic is a part of a larger effort to drive social change. Our management, staff members, students especially NSS volunteers and NCC cadets came together to take responsibility. These Corona warriors undertook many activities to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

The Practice:

Objectives of the Practice were fulfilled by successful implementation of following activities-

- **Sanitizer preparation and distribution-** Department of Chemistry prepared hand sanitizer and distributed to every departments of college, needy students and non teaching members. During this pandemic, the institution used to welcome and felicitate the guests by giving this sanitizer and follow the practice to aware the people for Covid-19.
- **Mask preparation and distribution** - All the sweepers and Swachhata doot were felicitated by giving them mask and sanitizers. Crystal Club of Chemistry Department distributed masks to needy students and non teaching staff members. Alumni association distributed masks and sanitizer in society.
- **Awareness Campaign-** "NO MASK- NO ENTRY" signs were put up at various places and everyone was warned and instructed to wear a mask. Awareness about corona was

created among the students through various activities like Online Quiz, Essay Competition and Poster competition. During online teaching and communications our teachers time to time shared their knowledge about the Corona Virus, Safety Measures to prevent from virus, Symptoms of Corona Virus and how the virus is spreading among people. They also explained the ways to improve immunity of body and food style which could prevent from viral infections.

- **Cleaning and Sanitation**- During the Corona pandemic, the entire campus and all the classrooms were cleaned time to time by NSS volunteers, non-teaching staff and swachhata doot in collaboration with the sanitation envoys. The Sanitization Drive was also done at Public Health Centre (PHC) and Gram Panchayat Office at Adopted village Apoti Khurd (Aapatapa).
- **Installation of “Sensor based sanitizer instrument” and “sanitizer pedal stand”**- Sensor based sanitizer instrument was placed near administrative office and a sanitizer pedal stand was placed near the main entrance of the college to keep hygiene and prevent infection in the population.
- **Provided Corona warriors** - Seven students of microbiology department performed the job in Government Medical College as laboratory technician for covid19 testing.
- **Financial help to corona affected needy people:** Institute donated Rs. 2,53,448/- on 17/06/2021 by cheque no. 118486 to Maharashtra Chief Minister’s Relief Fund- COVID 19. Many teachers gave personal financial help to corona affected needy families of our students.
- **Blood donation camp** - Blood donation camp was organized in association with Government Hospital, Akola
- **Distribution of Food kits to corona affected needy families:** NSS unit Distributed Food kits to corona affected needy families of slum area.
- **Physical fitness activities** – With the aim to bust immunity and physical fitness during corona pandemic, Department of Physical education undertook various activities like - Yoga Practices, Online practical video session presentation (Physical Fitness Exercises) competition, Certificate Course in Physical Fitness, Physical Fitness and awareness programme for students and parents etc.

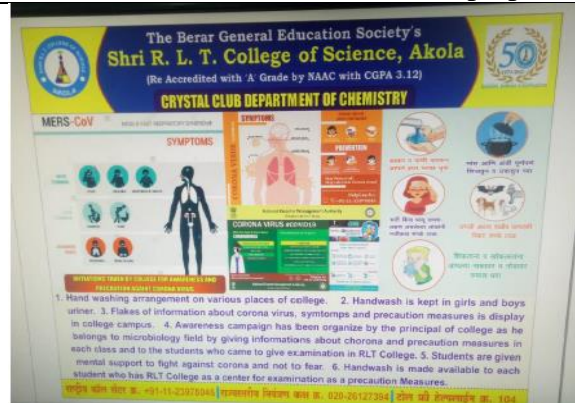

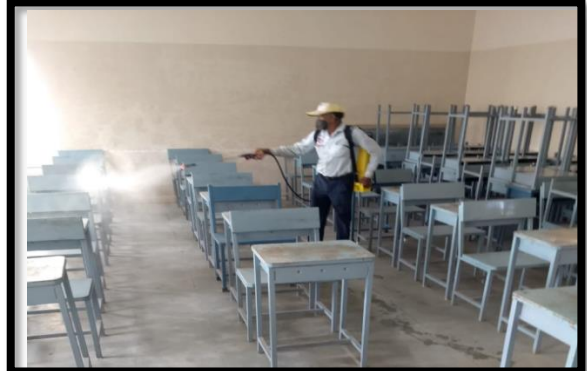

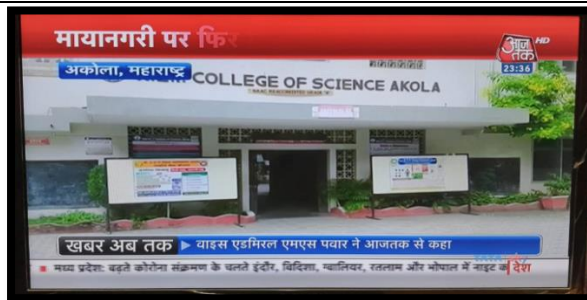

Best Practice 2:

Title of Practice: To nurture the culture of environment consciousness not only among the students and faculty members but also in society.

The Context: One of the most glaring problems which the world faces today is the environmental pollution. There is an immediate need to make people aware about environmental degradation. Fostering a culture of environmental consciousness among the young generation is the need of the hour. Education and public participation may change and improve the quality of environment. As young citizens and future decision makers in society, students have to be inspired and engage with a sense of commitment and responsibility to protect our environment. Voluntary participation in activities may enable them to nurture environmental consciousness. Environment love, sensitivity and awareness can create a sense of respect towards nature and mother earth.

The Practice:

To nurture the culture of environment consciousness following activities were undertaken by our Institute-

- **Plantation Drive:** NSS and NCC Team of Shri R.L.T. College of Science, Akola, in collaboration with Forest Office, Akola carried out plantation by keeping social distancing and by taking precautionary measures. The plantation drive was arranged at Shivapur near Sun City, Malkapur as well as at adopted village Apoti khurd. Department of Botany developed Nursery of saplings grown from naturally occurring seedlings. Gifting of plants is made as a practice for welcoming the guests for all programs of college. Speciality of these programme was Higher quantity of oxygen producing plants were planted. Outdoor plants like Tecomastans,.Nyctanthesarbor-tristis, Sapindusmukorossi, Bauhinia recemosa,Putranjivaroxburghi, Dalbergiasissoo, Anthocephaluscadamba, Moringaolifera, Murrayakoenigi , Neriumindica & Some Indoor or In shade plants like Ocimum sanctum, Ficusbenjamina, Dyspsislutescens, Dracenatrifasciata were planted.
