Considering the importance of these exams for the future careers of the students, The Berar General Education Society's Shri R.L.T. College of Science, Akola, Department of Mathematics in collaboration with IQAC was organized "Online Mathematics quiz" based on the syllabus of NET/SET exam for the subject Mathematics from 30th June to 1st July 2021.

First of all in regular college lecture, the students were explained the information and importance of the NET/SET exam. The syllabus of NET/SET exam for the subject Mathematics was provided to students.
