Colleges should enter into Memorandum of Understandings with the best colleges in Maharashtra for student exchange, so that students can learn and acquire good things from other colleges."

Dr Malkhede said that there are many areas of employment that need to be explored and

if the curriculum is developed accordingly, our students will acquire skills and it will be easy for them to get employment or to start their own businesses. Colleges should report any problems to the Vice-Chancellor by mail, he said.

**APPOINTMENT OF PAPER SETTERS FOR PH.D. ENTRANCE TEST (PET)  
BASED ON POST GRADUATE COURSES IN DIFFERENT SUBJECTS.**

**Item No. 19 :**

To prepare a panel of at least five persons, considered suitable for Appointment of paper setter, for inclusion of their names in the list of paper setters by the committee constituted by the Board of Examinations & Evaluation for the purpose of conducting Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET) based on post graduate courses in different subjects.

- (Notes :
- 1) Earlier PAT was conducting online with objective multiple choice questions. The management council in its meeting held on 15.2.2012 has resolved vide item no. 95, to reconstruct the process of conducting this examination in accordance with the U.G.C. Regulation, 2009.
  - 2) In accordance with the decision of the management council, the pat examination committee in its meeting held on 20.5.2012 has recommended for conducting the examination online as Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET), comprising two papers of multiple choice objective questions. The second paper will be based on syllabus of respective post graduate subject. For paper II, the process of preparing questions will be done. The appointed examiners on the panel given by the B.O.S. will prepare question paper set for relevant subjects. The question set will be moderated by the subject exam committee. From amongst these question sets, the question bank committee will select questions for paper II.
  - 3) Item is placed before the Board of Studies for giving panel of paper setters in the respective P.G. subjects)

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PAPER SETTERS.**

**Item No. 20 :**

To consider changes, if any, in the existing instructions/ to prepare instructions for the paper setters, taking in to consideration the relevant provisions of the Ordinance/Regulation/Rules/Syllabi/Notification for setting a question paper of each examination.

- (Notes :
- (1) The instructions for the paper setters given by the Board of Studies for the preceding examinations are appended herewith as **Appendix- 'E'**.
  - (2) The board of studies should take care that the instructions for the paper setters should be based on the pattern of question paper provided below as notified vide Notification No. 20 of 1986, dated 21/8/1986, where the syllabi is unitized.

**Pattern of question paper :**

- a) Total number of questions to be set in a paper will be the number required to be answered hitherto fore.
- b) Questions will be of two types.
  - (1) long answer type, and
  - (2) short answer type.
- c) Division of marks between long answer and short answer questions will be in the ratio of 40 to 60. Any fraction in case of long answer question will be disregarded and in case of short answer question will be rounded of to one.



- d) For every question, long answer type or short answer type, there will be an alternate choice. However, there will be no internal choice in a question.
  - e) Each short answer type question shall contain 4 to 8 short sub-questions with no internal choice.
- (3) If the Board of Studies desires to change the pattern of question paper decided for the utilized syllabi of the subject/s / paper/s which shall amount to change the instructions to the paper setter/s, the resolution to this effect be recommended by the Board to the Faculty and Academic Council.)

#### CHANCES TO FAILURE STUDENTS OF SEMESTER PATTERN COURSE.

##### Item No. 23 :

To provide chances to failure students of semester pattern course of semester-I to VI for under graduate & I to IV for Post Graduate students.

- (Notes : (1) As the authority of the University has resolved to implement phase wise Choice Based Credit system to the U.G. & P.G. Programmes from 2022-2023 session. Hence it is necessity to provide chances to the failure students of Sem-I & Sem-II (2022-2023) of Semester pattern.

**PREPARATION OF SUGGESTIVE LIST OF RELEVANT AND ALLIED SUBJECTS WITHIN THE PURVIEW OF BOARD OF STUDIES/ADHOC COMMITTEE IN REGARDING EACH POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSE.**

**Item No. 24 :**

To prepare a suggestive list of "Relevant" and "Allied" subjects against the Concerned subjects in regarding each Postgraduate Degree within the purview of Board of Studies for the purpose of appointments to the post of Asstt. Professors in the affiliated colleges and the University, in view of the decision of the Academic Council under Item No. 57 of its meeting held on 04.12.2020 and the decision of the Management Council under Item No. 106 of its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 accepting the recommendations of the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor on the resolution of Academic Council vide Item No. 46 of its meeting held on 30.07.2020.

(Recommendations of Committee enclosed vide Page Nos. C - 8725 To C- 8726)

**Notes :-** 1) At present the appointments by direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor are made as per UGC Regulation-2018 as accepted by Govt. Resolution dated 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 under the University's Direction No. 8/2019. In the said UGC Regulation (Para-4.1) and GR.(Para5.1) the qualification for appointment of Assistant Professor is prescribed as "A Master's Degree with 55% marks in a Concerned/ relevant/allied subject."

The term Concerned/ relevant/allied subject is prescribed by UGC and accepted by G.R., from current 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission Regulation-2018 where as in 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission Regulation only, "Relevant subject" was prescribed. The current term is in force from the G.R. Dated 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2019.

2) The U.G.C. vide its clarification in September 2015 has stated as under on the query on "Relevant Subject" in earlier Regulation 2010

Query	Clarification
4. What does relevant subject mean by provision in Para 4.4 when recruiting a candidate for Commerce subject, does a candidate having MBA (Management subject) become relevant subject for Commerce	The relevance of subject of interdisciplinary nature of subject, is required to be decided by the concerned University/Appointing Authority with the help of subject experts in the concerned/related field as per its requirement UGC Regulations. 210 defines the same.

3) Public Service Commission of Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh, have published the notification of list of basic Subject and the Concerned/ relevant/allied subjects.

4) As per Direction No. 14/2019 on UGC Regulation – 2018, the subject experts / panels are nominated by the University on Selection Committees, for appointments of Asstt. Professors in colleges.

5) As per section 41(i) of the Act, the Board of Studies have the powers to design the curricula of subjects.

6) The Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor with reference to Item No. 46 of Academic Council of its meeting 30.07.2020 has considered the matter in its meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup>, 13 August, 2020 & 6<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 and submitted the recommendations

to the Academic Council which has approved it vide Item No. 57 in 04.12.2020 and then the Management Council has approved the same vide Item No. 106 in 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 meeting.

7) In the recommendation of Committee at Sr. No. (8) it is recommended that on the basis of the specifications given above, the Boards of Studies shall prepare suggestive list of Relevant/Allied Subject. The recommendations have been accepted by the Academic Council and the Management Council as mentioned above.

Subject: Regarding revision of B.Sc and M.Sc curriculum for Biochemistry and Microbiology

Respected Sir,

I am writing this letter to bring to your notice about the requirement to revise the syllabus of UG and PG for Biochemistry and Microbiology. The need has been raised considering the challenges faced by the students after completion of the respective programs. Microbiology and Biochemistry are the major subjects in life sciences. When the students opt for exams like NET-JRF, SET and GATE, they are required to have in depth knowledge of their subjects. Often students lack experimental skills and scientific temper even after post-graduation program. When students are hired for jobs, they are overwhelmed by the techniques and working systems.

To curb these problems, the curriculum needs to be revised considering the challenges faced by the students. The following suggestions can be implemented:

- The syllabus of B.Sc and M.Sc should focus on channeling the concepts of the subjects with respect to various competitive exams.
- Skill development and hands-on training can be done by introducing a module for skill development along with the theory syllabus.
- The students can be prepared for new workplace by introducing internship or field training in the curriculum.
- Considering the recent COVID-19 pandemic, a specialization on Virology can be introduced in P.G. Microbiology.

As per the above scenario, I request you to consider these suggestions for the forthcoming syllabus revision.
