The Alumni feedback on curriculum – 27


The Employer feedback on curriculum – 10

Following suggestion were undertaken for discussion


1. Syllabi completion and use of ICT in teaching methodology
2. Career oriented course should be started (Alumni)
3. New courses should be open which develops entrepreneur skill
4. Physical/ Inorganic chemistry practical syllabus of (Sem III and IV) should be revised
5. Skill enhancement module should be incorporated
6. Considering recent covid 19 pandemic, specialization in virology must be introduced
7. Update the syllabus in computer science (ios, android etc)
8. Design the application based syllabus for enhancing employability.
9. Introduced some industry oriented subjects.
