- 1.5 "Sexual Harassment of Students" means the use of authority by any person incharge of the Management or any person employed by it to exploit the sexuality or sexual identity of a student to harass in a manner which prevents or impairs that student's full employment of educational benefits, climate or opportunities. It includes faculty/non-faculty behavior that covertly or overtly uses the power inherent in the status of a Professor/Reader/Lecturer/non-teaching staff, etc to affect negative a student's educational experience or career opportunities on the basis of sexual identity and or to threaten, coerce or intimidate a student to accept sexual advances or risk reprisal in terms of a grade, a recommendation, a professional growth opportunity or job.
- 1.6 "Sexual Harassment of Employee" means use of an authority by any person incharge of the management or any person employed by it to exploit the sexuality or sexual identity of an employee to harass in a manner which prevents or impairs the employees' full utilisation of employment benefits, climate or opportunities. It includes employer/fellow staff/non-teaching staff behavior that covertly or overtly uses the power inherent in the status of Employee's work experience or career opportunities on the basis of sexual identity and or to threaten, coerce or intimidate an employee(Teaching Staff/Non-teaching Staff) to accept sexual advances or making employment decision affecting the individual or create an intimidating, hostile or offensive working environment.
- 1.7 Women Professor means a lady teacher working in the University Department and affiliated colleges.

CLAUSE II:

PROHIBITION OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT

There shall be no harassment of women members whether student or employee within the educational institutions or in any place away from such institutions, if such place has a relevance or any bearing on the relationship as employer/employee/student/persons incharge of Management of the Educational Institutions.

CLAUSE III:

PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR SEXUAL HARASSMENT

3.1 The Head of the Institution shall, having regard to the location, environment and the like, of the educational institution concerned, take every step within his/her means to initiate action to identify spots or places and spheres of activity which are prone to harassment whether between students or between students and employees(teaching and non-teaching staff) of the education institutions or between employees themselves or between persons incharge of management and employee and shall make adequate arrangements with the view to prevent sexual harassment.

3.2 Constitution of the Grievance Committee :



bodies in Colleges

- A. Students must not loiter in the college compound or in the corridors. They should spend their leisure time in the library.
- B. While ascending or descending the stairs, students should avoid over crowding and shouting. They must keep to their left on the stairs.
- C. Students are strictly forbidden to enter the office, Professors, common room and Principal's office without permission.
- D. Noisy behavior by any student in the college premises, lecture hall or near the office is strictly prohibited.
- E. Students shall be in their seats in the classroom before star of the lecture. No student should enter or leave the class without permission.
- F. Student not attending the theory classes of a particular subject will not be allowed to attend the practical of the subject. irregular attendance in their theory or practical may lead to not forwarding the examination application form to university, if attendance is less than 75%.
- G. Students must take proper care of the college properties such as furniture and electrical fixtures etc. Any damage done to the college property will have to be made good by them and also they are liable to be removed from the college with bad remarks.
- H. Students must not bring with them unauthorized person in the college premises Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who violate this rule.
- I. Students are not allowed to carry personal possessions like Jewellry items, Purse, cash, gold, etc. in the college campus.
- j. The use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the college campus.

General Rules :-

Every student of this college has to follow the dress code prescribed by the college.



Women Cell/ Internal Complaint Committee (ICC)

The Women cell/ Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) of Shri RLT College of Science, Akola was formally constituted with Nine members it consists of (Faculty member, Non-teaching and Student representative) to probe into the student grievances. It redresses the grievances at departmental level and grievances of common interest will be forwarded to the ICC. The Cell maintains a conducive and unprejudiced educational environment. Complaints of students and parents are redressed as soon as they are received. All complaints are scrutinized by the Women Cell/ICC Cell and the resolutions are recorded.

Objectives

- Women Cell/Internal Complaint Committee (ICC)
- Cell to Prevent Sexual Harassment of Women

Grievance Handling Mechanism

- The Women Cell/ICC shall follow the principles of natural justice while considering the grievances
- Student aggrieved can send their grievance through suggestion boxes which is situated near main building (Wing D) or through Personal Contact to the Women Cell/ICC Cell.
- All complaints are collected, analysed, scrutinized and handled by the College Women Cell/ICC
- After scrutinize the complaints, General in nature (Teacher, Facilities and Examination) complaints are addressed by College Women Cell/ICC Cell and other complaints are send to respective cells as per it's nature to 'Anti Ragging Cell' (physical and psychological harm) and 'Cell to Prevent Sexual Harassment of Women' (discrimination, harassment, retaliation or sexual assault at all levels)
- The ICC shall resolve the grievance within period of fifteen days of receiving the complaint
- The Women Cell/ICC Cell shall provide a copy of the order to the aggrieved person(s).
- After receiving the complaint, the concerned parties are called and give equal opportunities to put their point of views. This process makes it more transparent and unbiased.
- If required Women Cell/ICC Cell will forward grievances to management on the basis of severity of the issue.

Criterion V : Student Support and Progression

Depending on the seriousness of the problem, the issues are settled by the Cell or by the Principal in consultation with other members of the management, parents and faculty. The collective efforts of the management, department heads, class teachers, various staff coordinators of clubs and associations and the ICC resolve the complaints promptly and efficiently. The effective complaint management mechanism improves better stakeholder relationship and contentment. Due to existence of Women Cell/ICC the students, teachers and non-teaching staff get a functional platform to share their issues and grievances. The judicious resolution and vigorous engagement of Women Cell/ICC has resulted in creation of faith and belief in the system. This has resulted in the development of vibrant, friendly and conducive environment in the institution.
