


Cleaning public garden and statues of great leaders and Freedom fighters




Festival Diwali brings in boundless enthusiasm and happiness. As an organisation, to complement employee's energy, this festival was celebrated on 19th October 2017.










One day workshop on "Eco-friendly Ganesha Idol Preparation






A workshop for parents and students on "Nutritional Empowerment During Covid Pandemic"








