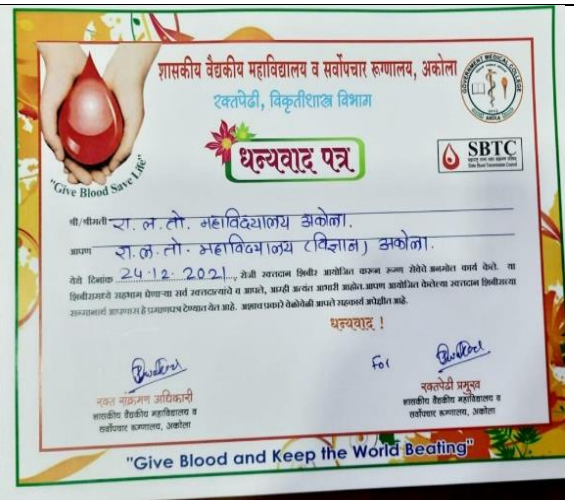

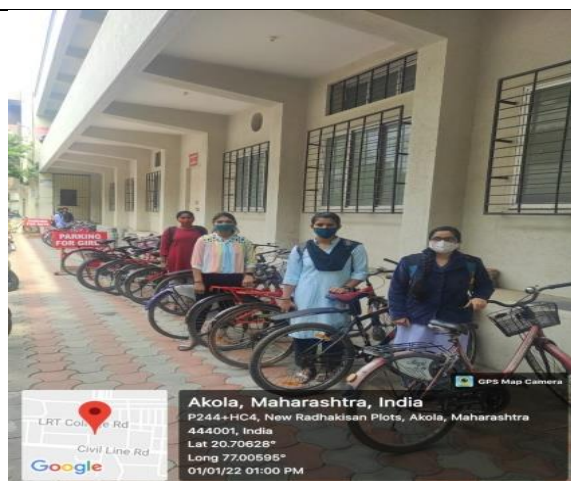
Environmental consciousness: Following activities were conducted by college to encourage students to live a greener lifestyle.

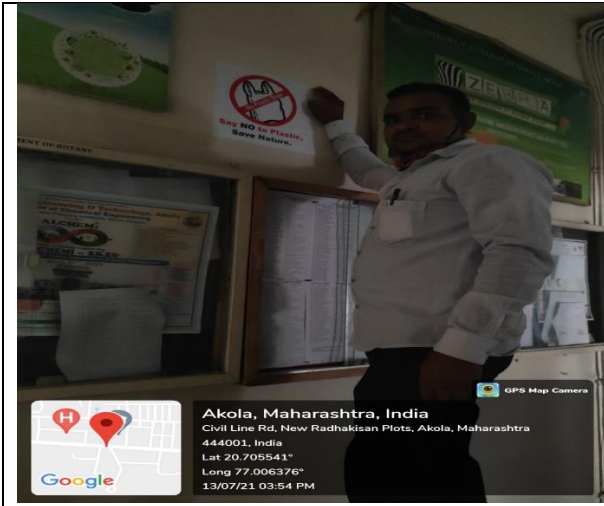
Discipline & Code of Conduct

- J. Students are appealed to use bicycles or e-vehicles to encourage healthy, sustainable and eco-friendly mode of transport to the college

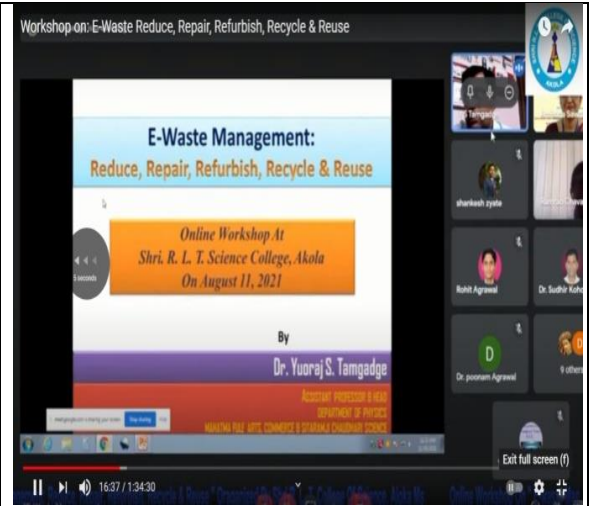
