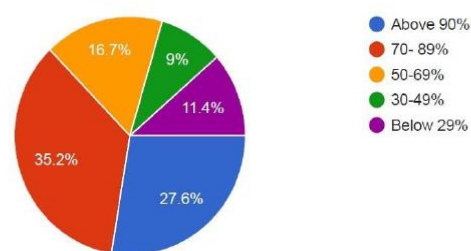

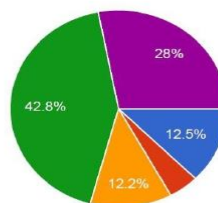

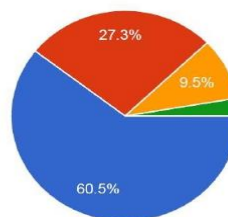


As per the guidelines of UGC, in order to enable the students belonging to the communities SC, ST, OBC and minorities, who need remedial coaching to come up to the level necessary for pursuing higher studies effectively and to reduce their failure and drop-out rate, "Remedial Coaching Classes for SC, ST, OBC and Minorities" was started in Shri R.L.T. College of Science, Akola from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010 under the guidance of Principal Dr. Vijay D. Nanoty. These classes were extended to other academically weaker students from the session 2018-19.

In the session 2019-20 actual teaching was started from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019 and total 446 students of B.Sc.-II and B.Sc.-III were get benefitted. Total 26 faculty members were engaged in the teaching work for strengthening the subject knowledge, upgrading the practical skill and for improving the academic skill and conceptual understanding of the students in various subjects.

Some guest lectures of eminent academicians were arranged for the students to create interest in the subject and to clear the basic ideas about the subject. The students were encouraged to participate in workshops, seminars, webinars, quizzes etc. organized by the college and other institutes.

The subjects covered under remedial coaching classes were Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Mathematics, Microbiology, Physics and Zoology. Question bank and model answer papers along with reading material and notes were provided to the students. Overall coaching was carried out at departmental level on non-remunerative basis.

In order to enable the students of SC, ST, OBC and minority communities, that are in need of remedial coaching to come up to the level necessary for taking higher education successfully and to bring down their drop-out rate and failure, "Remedial Coaching Classes for SC, ST, OBC and Minorities" was started in Shri R.L.T. College of Science, Akola as per the guidelines of UGC from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010 under the guidance of Principal Dr. Vijay D. Nanoty. From the session 2018-19, these classes were extended to other academically weaker students.

In the session 2020-21 total 408 students of B.Sc.-II and B.Sc.-III were admitted. Due to Covid-19 pandemic, actual teaching was done in the month of February-2021 and May-2021 through the online platform of Google Meet, Zoom and YouTube. Overall 26 faculty members of different departments were engaged in the teaching work for strengthening the subject knowledge, upgrading the practical skill and for improving the academic skill and conceptual understanding of the students in various subjects. The subjects covered were Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Mathematics, Microbiology, Physics and Zoology.

Students were encouraged to participate in various e-workshops, webinars, online quizzes and guest lectures of eminent academicians organized by the college and other institutes to create interest and to clear the basic ideas about the subject. MCQ's, question bank, reading material, books and notes were provided to the students in pdf format. Overall coaching was carried out at departmental level on non-remunerative basis.
