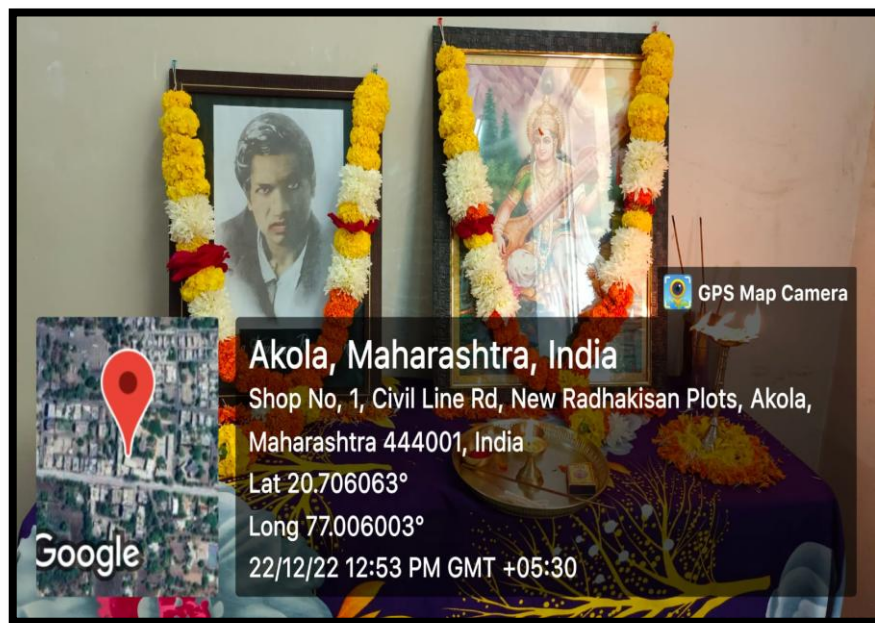


A Report on Celebration of

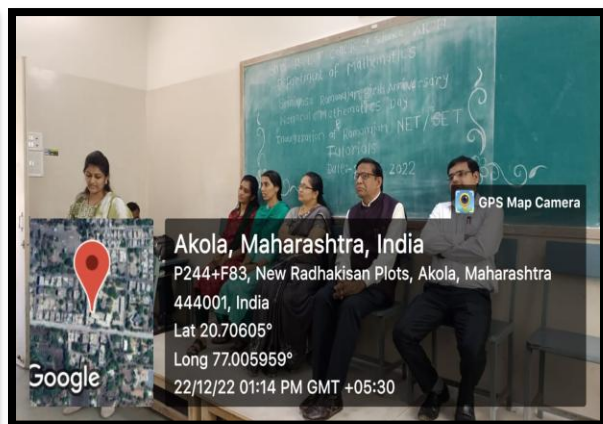
