The concept behind this is to motivate the students regarding the environment consciousness too.



Shri Guptaji explained the detail process of how plastic is converted into oil to students. The main thing is that the overall working of the industry is 100 percent atom economical. That is the plastic is converted into oil, the gases which are evolved are used as fuel and the remaining black carbon is also used in dying and burning purpose.



Students asked many questions and all are satisfactorily answered by the Gupta sir. The students learned many things from this industrial tour .

From there we visited to Rasoi Masala industry of M.I..D.C, Akola. There Mr. Aashish chandrana explained the detail process of preparation of papad, spices and many more to the students. 
