# NSS UNIT: COVID-19 Relief Task Force

## **Objectives of the Practice:**

- Awareness campaign among students and Society to fight against covid-19.
- Psychosocial counselling
- Mask preparation and distribution.
- To distribute sanitizer.
- Cleaning and Sanitation Drive in college campus and at adopted village.
- To help local community for their wellbeing during lockdown period.
- To encourage and provide NSS Volunteers as Corona warriors.
- Financial and other help to needy people.
- Physical Fitness Development Programmes for students, staff and society.
- To organize free of cost Covid-19 vaccination camps for students, employees and society.

## **The Practice:**

- Awareness Campaign- Awareness about corona was created among the students and society through various activities like Street plays, Online Quiz, Essay Competition, Poster competitions, webinars etc. Awareness was created for the promotion of health through the video van of Zilla Parishad Health Department. Posters like stay home stay safe, Jaan Hai to Jahan Hai...etc. are made by students for spreading awareness about covid-19 pandemic. During online teaching and communications our teachers time to time shared their knowledge about the Corona Virus, Safety Measures to prevent from virus, Symptoms of Corona Virus and how the virus is spreading among people. They also explained the ways to improve immunity of body and food style which could prevent from viral infections. Some staff members published Newspaper articles about corona awareness. NSS team gave Covid-19 vaccination information to school children of adopted village Apoti Khurd. Also, raised awareness about vaccination by holding a rally in the adopted village Apoti. Student Volunteers worked at the call centre of Akola Municipal Corporation to telephonically aware the families for doing Covid vaccination. "NO MASK- NO ENTRY" signs were put up at various places and everyone was warned and instructed to wear a mask.
- **Psychosocial counselling** Principal Dr. V.D. Nanoty addressed about covid-19 to staff as well as through YouTube video on online platform. Counselling of the girl students staying in the college hostel was done by the senior female professors. The women of Adopted Village Apoti were instructed by the program officer Dr. Rashmi Joshi on 'how to protect themselves and their families from Corona.' On Women's Day, 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Women cell

and Internal Complaint Committee of college organized online guest lecture on topic 'Corona: current situation and women's mental health (कोरोना सद्यस्थिती आणि महिलांचे मानसिक स्वास्थ्य).'

On 12<sup>th</sup> January 2022, NSS unit and Parent Teacher Association organized a workshop and interactive session on 'Nutritional empowerment during covid pandemic' for students and parents. Thus, tried our level best for psychosocial counselling of students, parents and society.

- Mask preparation and distribution NSS Volunteers prepared mask at home and distributed to needy people. All the sweepers and Swachhata doot were felicitated by giving them mask and sanitizers.
- **Cleaning and Sanitation** During the Corona pandemic, the entire campus and all the classrooms were cleaned time to time by NSS volunteers, non-teaching staff and swachhata doot in collaboration with the sanitation envoys. The Sanitization Drive was also done at Public Health Centre (PHC) and Gram Panchayat Office at Adopted village Apoti Khurd (Aapatapa).
- Installation of "Sensor based sanitizer instrument" and "sanitizer pedal stand"- Sensor based sanitizer instrument was placed near administrative office and a sanitizer pedal stand was placed near the main entrance of the college to keep hygiene and prevent infection in the population.
- **Blood Donation camps** NSS unit organized Blood Donation camp on 24<sup>th</sup> December in collaboration with Govt. Medical College Blood transfusion Unit, Akola to provide blood to needy people.
- **Provided food kits and essential items to the needy** NSS unit Distributed Food kits to corona affected needy families of slum area. On 30<sup>th</sup> October 2020, college student's representative Bhushan Gondachvar and group distributed food items, fruits and clothes at Matoshree Vruddhashram. On NSS Foundation Day, 24 Sept. 2021, Food and essential items were distributed at Suryodaya Bal Griha Akola. Fruits, biscuits and masks were distributed to the female patients in the local district women's hospital jointly by the Women cell and IQAC of the college.
- **Physical fitness activities** With the aim to boost immunity and physical fitness during corona pandemic, Department of Physical education undertook various activities like Yoga Practices, online practical video session presentation about Physical Fitness, Certificate Course in Physical Fitness, Physical Fitness and awareness programme for students and parents etc.
- **Preventive measures during offline college-** To prevent the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in college and into the community; and to ensure the safety of students and staff physical distancing in and outside classrooms was maintained. Use of oximeter and thermal scanning of each student and staff was a regular practice.
- Survey for Covid-19 vaccination- Volunteers worked for doing the survey of nonvaccinated families in the areas allotted by the Corporation and Covid centers. Volunteers awared people and insist them to get vaccinated by Covid Vaccine.
- Organization of Covid-19 vaccination camps COVID-19 vaccination camps were organized in collaboration with Akola Municipal Corporation under the "Mission Yuva

Swasthya" campaign for college staff, students and society. On Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> October 2021, total 93 candidates above 18 years were administered the doses of Covishield vaccine. 75 villagers above 18 years of age were vaccinated at adopted village Apoti. The vaccination campaign of 150 children in the age group of 12 to 18 years was carried out for two consecutive days at Apoti village on 21 & 22 March 2022. Covid-19 vaccination camps for college students below 18 years was organized on 05<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2022.

Vaccination campaign became successful with kind cooperation of Dr. Asmita Pathak (Nodal Officer Covid, Akola Municipal Corporation) and Dr. Manish Sharma (District R.C.H. Officer Z.P. Akola.), Management, Principal Dr. V.D. Nanoty, Nodal officer Dr. Rashmi Joshi, all teaching staff, non-teaching staff and volunteers






