A) WILD LIFE CONSERVATION WEEK PROGRAM: (01/10/2022 to 07/10/2022)








B) THE PROJECT ON "FISH DIVERSITY IN AKOLA REGION": (3 Oct 2023)

C) POSTER COMPETITION ON THEME 'RECOVERING KEY SPECIES FOR ECOSYSTEM RESTORATION'




E) SEMINAR COMPETITION:



Mr. Dheeraj Madane, RFO, Patur proposed the vote of thanks. The program concluded with the permission of the President.




