Celebrations of National and International Commemorative Days and Events During session 2022-23

- ➤ Maharashtra Agriculture Day: 1st July 2022 was observed to honor the dedication of farmers and their contribution to promoting agricultural practices. This day is celebrated in honor of the Father of Green Revolution Vasant Rao Phulsingh Naik.
- ➤ **Independence Day:** The college celebrated Independence Day on the 15th of August 2022. Principal Dr. V. D. Nanoty hoisted the flag and delivered a speech highlighting the significance of Republic Day to the students and staff.
- ➤ National Sports Day: On the occasion of National Sports Day on 29th August, Sports achievers were felicitated, and from 23rd to 29th of August the week was celebrated by organizing various sports competitions.
