Short report of Activities taken in the Institution for inculcating values for being responsible citizens

The college has tried to inculcate various values among the students and staff in order to be responsible citizens through various activities as follows-

• Student Induction Programme :2022-23 (Code of conduct awareness program, Duration: 01.08.2022 to 06.08.2022):

Shri R.L.T. College of Science organized "Student Induction Programme" for students of B.Sc.-I from Monday, 01.08.2022 to Saturday, 06.08.2022. During this programme detail information about the college, university, national education policy, choice-based credit system, curriculum, syllabus, theory and practical classes, various academic, curricular, cocurricular, extra-curricular activities, college infrastructure, laboratories, library facilities, girls hostel, code of conduct, dress code, vision, mission, scholarships, timetable, academic calendar, examination pattern, internal assessment, class test, seminars, assignments, certificate courses, games and sports, cultural activities, NSS, NCC, DMC, sky observation club, slow fast learner scheme, remedial coaching, competitive examination study centre, equal opportunity centre, research facilities etc. was given to newly admitted students. 


Azadi ka Amrut Mohotsav celebration




• Marathi Bhasha Gaurav Din (27 -02-2023):
