The Institution has a Transparent mechanism for timely redressal of student grievances including sexual harassment and ragging cases

### Implementation of guidelines of statutory/regulatory bodies

- A. Students must not loiter in the college compound or in the corridors. They should spend their leisure time in the library.
- B. While ascending or descending the stairs, students should avoid over crowding and shouting. They must keep to their left on the stairs.
- C. Students are strictly forbidden to enter the office, Professors, common room and Principal's office without permission.
- D. Noisy behavior by any student in the college premises, lecture hall or near the office is strictly prohibited.
- E. Students shall be in their seats in the classroom before star of the lecture. No student should enter or leave the class without permission.
- F. Student not attending the theory classes of a particular subject will not be allowed to attend the practical of the subject. irregular attendance in their theory or practical may lead to not forwarding the examination application form to university, if attendance is less than 75%.
- G. Students must take proper care of the college properties such as furniture and electrical fixtures etc. Any damage done to the college property will have to be made good by them and also they are liable to be removed from the college with bad remarks.
- H. Students must not bring with them unauthorized person in the college premises Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who violate this rule.
- I. Students are not allowed to carry personal possessions like Jewellry items, Purse, cash, gold, etc. in the college campus.
- j. The use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the college campus.

# Report ICC / Women Cell 2023-24

### **Women Cell/Internal Complaint Committee (ICC)**

The Women cell/ Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) of Shri RLT College of Science, Akola was formally constituted with Nine members it consists of (Faculty member, Non-teaching and Student representative) to probe into the student grievances. It redresses the grievances at departmental level and grievances of common interest will be forwarded to the ICC. The Cell maintains a conducive and unprejudiced educational environment. Complaints of students and parents are redressed as soon as they are received. All complaints are scrutinized by the Women Cell/ICC Cell and the resolutions are recorded.

### **Objectives**

- Women Cell/Internal Complaint Committee (ICC)
- Cell to Prevent Sexual Harassment of Women

### **Grievance Handling Mechanism**

- The Women Cell/ICC shall follow the principles of natural justice while considering the grievances
- Student aggrieved can send their grievance through suggestion boxes which is situated near main building (Wing D) or through Personal Contact to the Women Cell/ICC Cell.
- All complaints are collected, analysed, scrutinized and handled by the College Women Cell/ICC
- After scrutinize the complaints, General in nature (Teacher, Facilities and Examination)
  complaints are addressed by College Women Cell/ICC Cell and other complaints are
  send to respective cells as per it's nature to 'Anti Ragging Cell' (physical and
  psychological harm) and 'Cell to Prevent Sexual Harassment of Women'
  (discrimination, harassment, retaliation or sexual assault at all levels)
- The ICC shall resolve the grievance within period of fifteen days of receiving the complaint
- The Women Cell/ICC Cell shall provide a copy of the order to the aggrieved person(s).
- After receiving the complaint, the concerned parties are called and give equal
  opportunities to put their point of views. This process makes it more transparent and
  unbiased.
- If required Women Cell/ICC Cell will forward grievances to management on the basis of severity of the issue.

Depending on the seriousness of the problem, the issues are settled by the Cell or by the Principal in consultation with other members of the management, parents and faculty. The collective efforts of the management, department heads, class teachers, various staff coordinators of clubs and associations and the ICC resolve the complaints promptly and efficiently. The effective complaint management mechanism improves better stakeholder relationship and contentment. Due to existence of Women Cell/ICC the students, teachers and non-teaching staff get a functional platform to share their issues and grievances. The judicious resolution and vigorous engagement of Women Cell/ICC has resulted in creation of faith and belief in the system. This has resulted in the development of vibrant, friendly and conducive environment in the institution.


We writing to express my concern and disappointment regarding the cleanliness of our common room. Despite repeated requests the room remains unclean and untidy

### Shri R.L.T. College of Science, Akola Report –Women's Cell & Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) 2023-24

The Committee executed its work as follows –

- As per the guideline about the formation of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) given by Maharashtra State Commission for women, Mumbai, Women's Cell & ICC was composed on 12.07.23 in Shri R.L.T. College of Science, Akola when the regular theory and practical classes started in the academic session 2023-24.
- Care was taken by the committee members for the comfort of the girl students by providing a common room for girl students, a separate vehicle parking, maintaining the cleanliness of the campus etc. The whole college premises are under observation of CCTV cameras by the Principal.
- The flex of ICC and suggestion box has been fixed near the Principal's office to collect girl's grievances. The Women's Cell & ICC circulated the notice for girl students to drop their suggestions, grievances in suggestion box. During this session the box was open four times in the months of August, October, January, & March. Most common complaints received were about the shortage of water and about the refill of sanitary napkins in vending machine.

Complaints were conveyed to Principal and with the help of nonteaching staff complaints were resolved.

• Women's Cell and Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) in collaboration with IIC and IQAC of Shri R. L. T. College of Science, Akola celebrated International Women's Day on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024. The program was presided over by Principal Dr.V.D.Nanoty. On this occasion all the women employees of the college were felicitated by the college by the hands of Dr. V. D. Nanoty. The first lady professor of the college, Dr. Archana Amley was felicitated with a shawl and bouquet.

In presidential speech, Dr. Nanoty appreciated the women employees of the college for their valuable contribution in the college work. The program was conducted by H.O.D. of Chemistry, Asso. Prof. Dr. Agrawal. Vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. Tadam.

















A one-day skill development workshop was organized for women of village at the Mahila Mela in NSS camp. Dr. Kavita Heda, National Program Officer, introduced the chief guests. The workshop provided training in making herbal products ((Perfumes, Mosquito repellents, Air freshner, Pain relief oil, Floral disinfections, Skin glowing cream etc), aiming to promote entrepreneurship among village women. Dr. Poonam Agrawal(H.O.D. of Chemistry, Crystal club), the resource person, trained the participants in a simple and effective manner. The goal was to empower village women and girls to start low-cost home industries without requiring significant capital investment. The workshop was presided over by Asst. Prof. Dr. Sujata Tadam, and the program was inaugurated by the Mahila Bachat Gat. The dais was graced by Prof. Dr. Archana Amley, Asst. Prof. Ms. Vaishali Badgujar, Asst. Prof. Dr. Anjali Sangole, Asst. Prof. Dr. Rashmi Joshi and Asst. Prof. Ms. Sonali Gawande. The event was attended by village women, and National Service Scheme girls."





• Due to the vigilance of the committee members together with all the staff members, the curricular as well as extra-curricular activities were carried out in a peaceful atmosphere in the college. There was no complaint of sexual harassment among the students and staff till date.
